

Creating Authentic Products

Differentiating by: Product / Interest and Learning Profile

Subject: Works for any subject

Examples:

- Parts of a Plant
- Math Concept
- New vocabulary
- Book Review/Report
- Branches of Government

Overview: Students are provided a menu of ideas to choose how they would like to share what they've learned by applying their knowledge to a final product.

- Create rubric and idea menu
- Idea menu may include: poem, song, skit, blog or vlog post, essay, or idea of their choice

Steps:

1. Provide students with a rubric detailing what must be included in the final product
2. Share the idea menu with students and allow them the opportunity to choose how they will represent their learning
3. Once complete, students have an opportunity to share their final product with others.
