

Strategy: Providing a Variety of Materials

Differentiating by: Readiness/Interest/Learning Profile

Overview:

Teachers can differentiate content based on readiness level, interests, or learning profile by offering a variety of materials. This allows students to access the information in the way that works best for them.

Examples:

1. Teachers might want to build a library of varied textbooks and supplemental materials for differentiating instruction.
2. Teachers might provide math manipulatives for students who need a more hands-on approach.
3. Teachers can design learning centers with multiple intelligences in mind.
